<b>Mathematical</b>	<b>Life and Learning</b>	<b>Government</b>
<b>Given</b>  Record pertinent data correctly and completely as given in the problem. What I know.	<b>I Am</b>  I know whose I am and where I am in His plan. I am <b>aware</b> of my situation and the characteristics of God.	<b>God and Land</b>
<b>Find</b>  Identify the methods and record in a logical and orderly way what is required to solve the problem.	<b>I Listen</b>  I listen to and follow the promptings of the spirit and receive an <b>assurance</b> of who I am and what I am to do.	<b>People and spirit</b>
<b>Analysis</b> (legislative)  Compose a lawful, logical and orderly plan that is needed to solve the problem using the language of mathematics.	<b>I Plan</b>  I study it out in my mind and with faith, then ask if it be right. I seek to <b>acquire</b> knowledge (mind) and understanding (heart). I know what I want. I know my purpose and mission.	<b>Congress</b>
<b>Solution</b> (executive)  Execute the plan mathematically as described in the analysis section. Work the plan!	<b>I Act</b>  I take <b>action</b> , apply the knowledge (mind) and understanding (heart) to my problem or choice.	<b>President</b>
<b>Check</b> (judicial)  Evaluate the results against the requirements of the problem to determine if it is solved correctly. If not, correct the plan and execute again to arrive at the correct answer.	<b>I Become</b>  I receive intelligence, a change of heart. I <b>achieve</b> a new level, an increase of faith to begin again	<b>Supreme Court</b>
